Suggested Equipment List

The *Cub Scout Leader Book* recommends the following items for a campout:

Personal Items

- Blankets, sheets (2 or 3)
- Waterproof ground sheet, plastic
- Sweater or jacket
- Pair of moccasins or sneakers
- Mosquito Repellant
- Tiger Cub, Wolf, Bear, or Webelos Scout book

Clothes Bag containing

- Extra handkerchiefs
- Set of extra clothes
- Extra socks or stockings

Repair Kit containing

- Safety pins
- Shoelaces
- Flashlight with extra batteries

Eating Kit containing

- Knife
- Fork
- Plate
- Cup
- Spoon

Toilet Kit containing

- Soap in container
- Toilet paper
- Washcloth
- Hand towel
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Comb

We suggest you consider a "day bag" to be carried through the day containing:

- Canteen or container for water
- A broad-brimmed hat or billed cap
- Rain gear
- Sunscreen

For those camping as a Den or Patrol, the following items would be useful to the group:

- Cooking fly or tarp
- Plastic tablecloth for meals
- Heavy-duty aluminum foil
- Hot pads for hot pots
- Liquid detergent for washing AND soaping the outside of pots prior to cooking over a wood fire
- 5 gallons of water for every 8 people and a water bucket or container to haul water, if needed
- Scrub pads
- Charcoal & fire starter/stove
- Battery or Propane Lantern
- Paper plates/cups/plastic utensils
- Paper towels
- Can opener
- Matches
- Den flag
- Toilet Paper
- Boots
- Lawn chairs
- Trash bags
